Jakarta Transportation Infrastructure Projects

which are currently being initiated, funded and operated by the Indonesian state-owned enterprises, have recently finished with regards to public investment project which promote the national economic growth.



Jakarta Flyover Roads

When finished the Jakarta Flyover Roads project will consist of two non-toll roads situated 10 meters above existing roads connecting Blok M to Antasari in South Jakarta and Tanah Abang in Central Jakarta to Kampung Melayu in East Jakarta. At a total cost of US\$140.8 million the project will help to alleviate traffic congestion within Indonesia's capital.



Jakarta New Priok Port

In order to ramp up the quality and quantity of its infrastructure, the Indonesian government has tasked its state-owned company Pelindo II to develop and operate an extension of the current Tanjung Priok harbour in North Jakarta, Indonesia's busiest trading port. The result will be a world class port with construction beginning in 2012 and completion expected by 2023.



Jakarta Mass Rapid Transit

The Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) project in Jakarta is a USD \$1.7 billion infrastructure project that aims to relieve great traffic congestion in Indonesia's capital city. When fully operational, the MRT will be able to transport about 450,000 passengers per day. The MRT consists of two corridors: (1) the North-South corridor and (2) the East-West corridor. Work has initially begun on the North-South corridor.

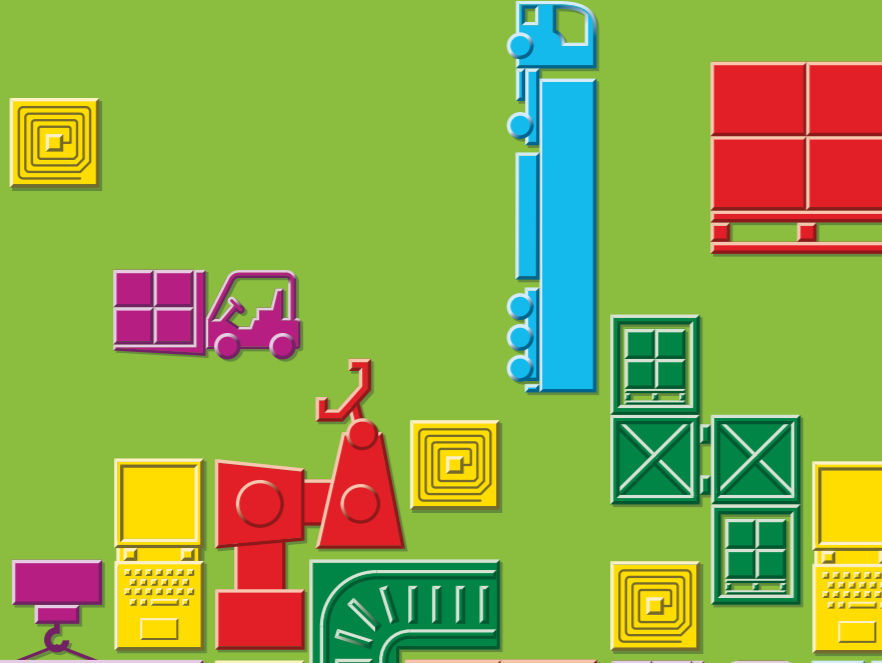

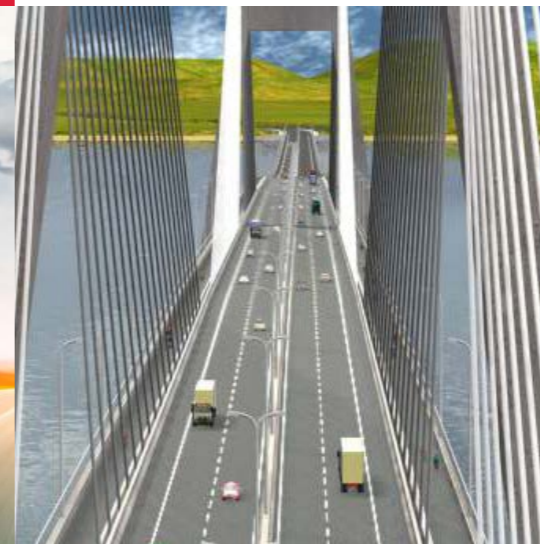

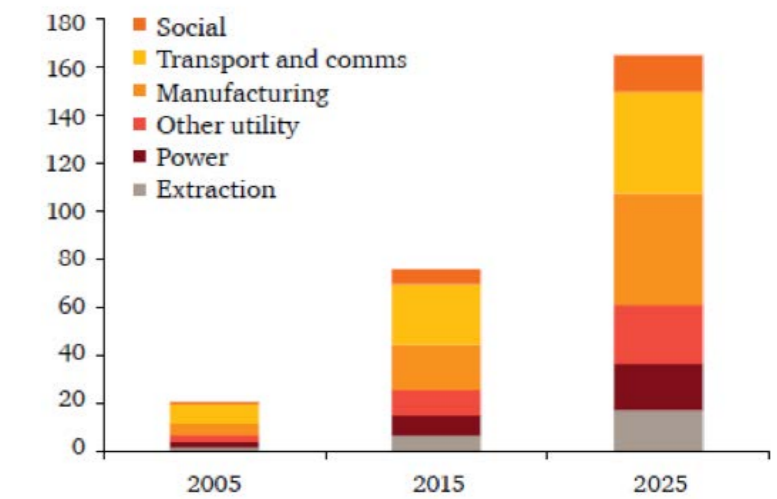
